Attributes, Suggestions from students, Action to be taken from Feedback

Sr. No.	Attributes	Action to be taken
1.	Cognitive, social, and emotional growth of students should be focused.	 Mentors taking monthly meetings to improve the rapport between mentor and mentees Frequency will be increased and the critical cases will be referred to counsellor for comfort and emotional growth of mentees
2.	Identification of weakness of student and to help them to overcome it.	 GFM identifies weakness of student in a particular area and accordingly the support is given i.e. in academics, sports, extra- curricular etc. Increase in awareness for student's counselling through mentor mentee system
3.	ICT Tool usage by teachers	 More number of teachers will be encouraged to use ICT, trainings will be provided to them. Teachers will be encouraged to use more number of ICT tools.
