




Faculties of various departments Celebrating 74th Independence Day (15th August 2020)









Students have attended the online session conducted on the occasion of NSS Day


Students and faculties performing yoga posture





The department of Computer Engineering organized an online session on "Yoga- Energizing the self" on the occasion of International Yoga Day on 22/06/2020






The Department of Information Technology organized an online session to celebrate Teacher's Day for appreciation and admiration of teachers.

The Department of Information Technology organized a session on the occasion of Engineers Day to aware students about responsibilities of Engineers towards society




Various department have celebrated Khande Navami by adoring the instruments (Ayudh Pooja)


