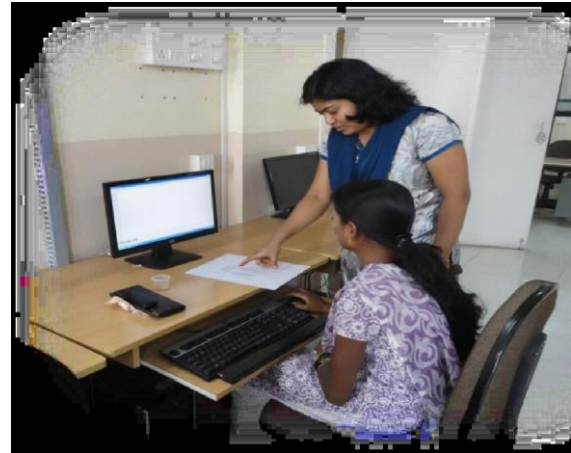

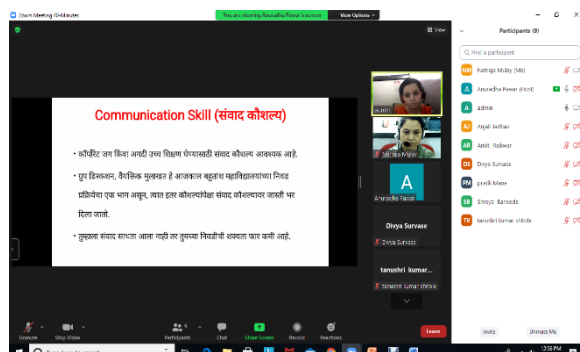


IT Awareness Program

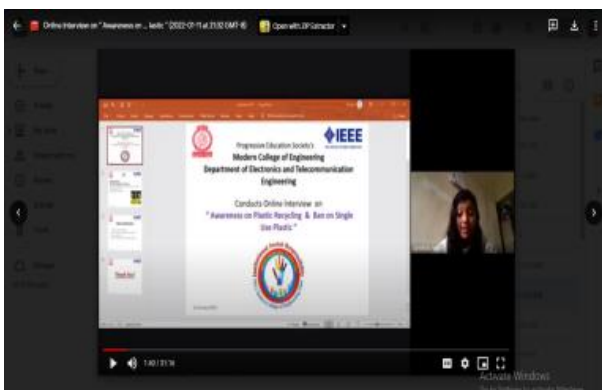

Social Talk

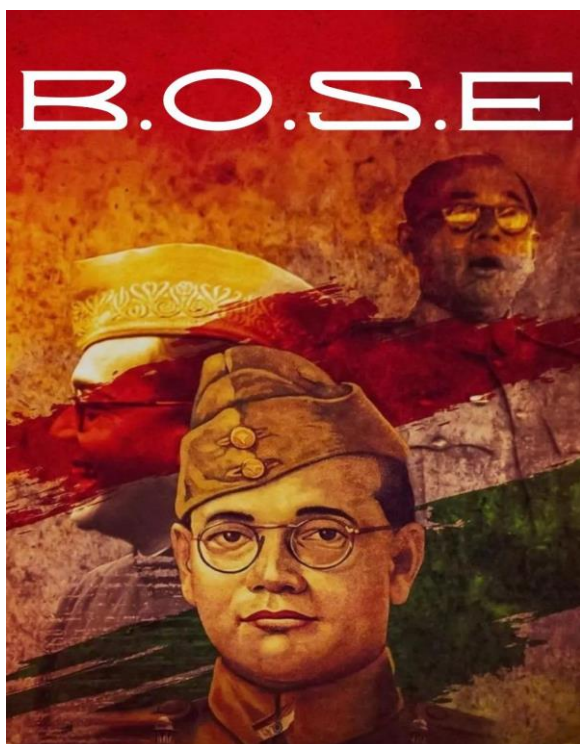
Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav

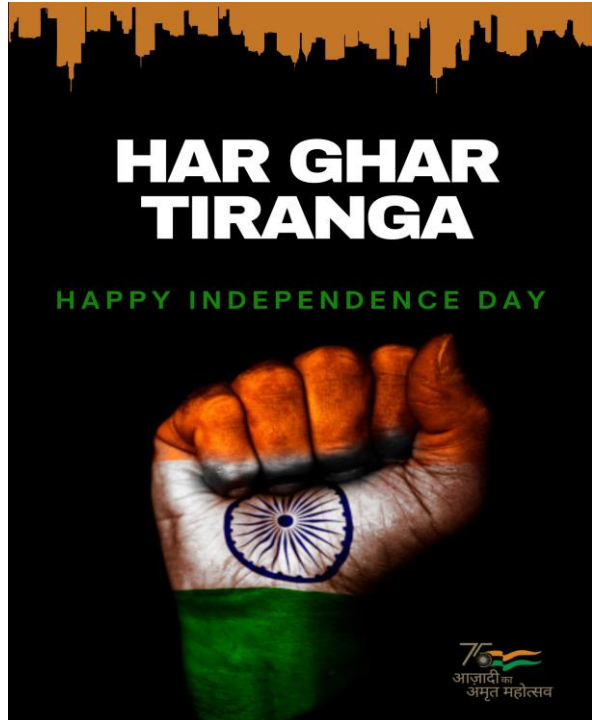
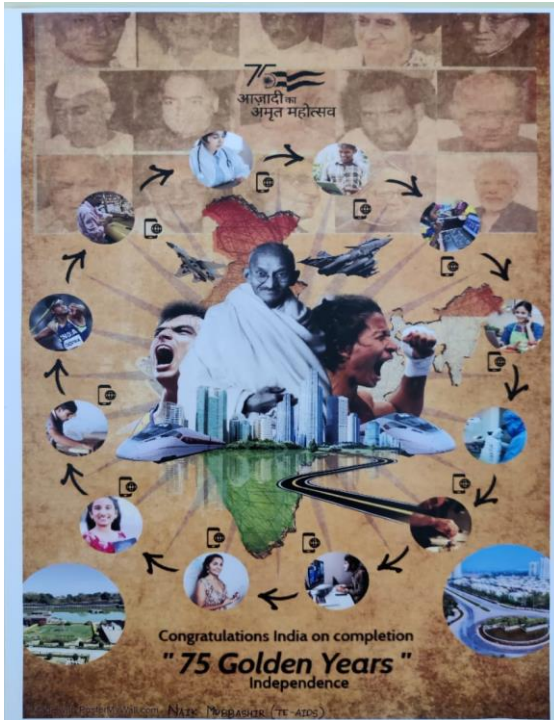
